### From the Desk of Deacon Tom Bates,

In the second reading for Sunday, St. Paul tells Timothy:

If we have died with him we shall also live with him; if we persevere we shall also reign with him.

But if we deny him he will deny us.

If we are unfaithful he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself.

Jesus loved us by dying on the cross so that we could live in His love. He wants us to love other people just as He loves us. Giving our lives freely and completely to our spouses is dying to ourselves to live with Christ. Sacrificing our lives for our children and our parents will allow them to experience the love of Christ. Helping those who need our help will enable them to see Christ and to live in His love.

Christ understands that some people will not follow Him and will deny Him in how they treat other people. Christ shows His love for those who deny Him by accepting their denial. He does not send Michael the Archangel with a flaming sword to force people to follow Him. Out of respect for their free will, He denies them. He allows them to be separated from Him so that they can experience the emptiness of their lives and return to Him.

When Christ denies people who turn away, He always remains faithful to them. He is always waiting to welcome them with open arms and tears of joy because He died for them out of love.

Christ will allow us to depart from Him, but He will always be waiting for us to turn back to Him.
