From the Desk of the Pastor,

St. Paul says today that we must be "persistent in proclaiming and teaching God's Word and out of season." It's the "out of season" that prompts this week's message from your pastor.

A few months ago, Pope Benedict XVI issued a document titled *Motu Proprio Summorum Pontificum* concerning the celebration of the Latin Mass before Vatican Council II. In a nutshell, what the Pope said in his letter is that priests no longer have to have permission from their bishop to say the Latin Mass, that is, as it was said before Vatican Council II. This, first of all, puts to rest the presumption that the "old Mass" was abrogated at Vatican II. It wasn't. That was never the intention. Moreover, the Vatican Council II documents state clearly that the "new Mass," the one we celebrate now, was to be celebrated in Latin, with celebration in the vernacular (English) as pastorally acceptable, but not necessarily as normative. But let's get back to the *Motu Proprio*. The Pope said that there are not two Masses...but two different forms of the same Mass. Bishop Swain issued a letter to all priests in the diocese on September 10 regarding implementation of the Pope's letter. Let me say from the outset, that at the present time, it will probably not affect us here at Holy Spirit. First, priests must be qualified to say the old Latin Mass. Second, there must be a stable group of the faithful who adhere to this earlier liturgical tradition. No such group exists at our parish, but that isn't to say with the growth of our parish that such a group would be present in the near future. Thus, if there was a demand for the pre-Vatican Council Latin Mass, Father Zilverberg or I would have to be trained in it. The important thing to remember, is this: It's the Church's Mass. Not yours...and not mine. And so we should see the great benefits that this offers to all the faithful. Once again, The Catholic Church is consistent, not only in what it believes, but how it proclaims God's word too.
