### **From the Desk of the Pastor,**

As I write this, the tragic news of the earthquake aftermath in Haiti continues to stream across our televisions and computers. May God help these poor people, and may we continue to pray and help where we can. The scenes have been riveting: One sees a dichotomy of great heroism on the one hand clash with the worst in human behavior on the other. When basic human needs are not met; self-preservation kicks in. The problem is – it can get sick and evil, as factions develop and violence escalates. We sit back and sigh, counting our blessings, while at the same time relieved that it's not happening here to us. In our Second reading for this Sunday, Paul confronts division and dissension in the Christian community at Corinth. Yes, even faith communities can fracture and divide, looking inward on themselves, resorting to another kind of self-preservation. Paul says there must not be divisions or dissension, for they are the Body of Christ. We are all different, but in baptism we become united in the faith. The Eucharist shows forth this unity. Our common liturgy is known by all. We make a profession of faith Sunday after Sunday as an intelligent assent to what we believe. All of this is to show that each of us is united with Christ, and that united in Christ, we are all one Body.

- Copy of child's certified birth certificate. SD law requires that students must be age 5 by September 1st (of the current year) to start Kindergarten.
- Complete and up-to-date immunization record. Students entering Kindergarten need a record of their Kindergarten physical, a second MMR and a chicken pox vaccine.
- Copy of the Child's Baptismal certificate, if applicable.
- Copy of the child's social security card.
- Completed Registration forms...available at the time of registration.
- \$25 non-refundable registration fee for preschool or \$50 non-refundable deposit for Kindergarten (applied toward tuition).
