From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar,

After calling Fr. Morgan's mother and telling her to make her son be nice to me, things have been the best they've ever been! Why didn't I think of it much sooner! All kidding aside, I thank God often to have Fr. Morgan as our pastor here at Holy Spirit Parish. I am glad he and I can joke around as we do, and most importantly pray together. Not only am I thankful for him, but I am also thankful for the staff at Holy Spirit. The ways in which they generously give of their time and how well we all get along is a true blessing of God. Lastly I am thankful for the main reason I am here: to serve you. I am particularly thankful for how you have given so generously to those in Haiti. We have risen just over \$22,000. This far exceeds what I thought we would raise as a parish. I thank God for your generous hearts. As said before, this money will be given to Catholic Relief Services (CRS), which uses 95 cents of every dollar to fund programs; amazingly only 5 cents of each dollar goes towards administration, fund raising, etc! To show how amazing this is, when we compare it to the Red Cross, we find that CRS has half the overhead costs on every dollar. You can be assured that your money is being very well spent. Thank you again for your generous hearts, "*for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me*".
