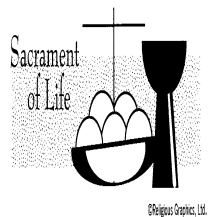

We are in need of families to host a team of 4 for supper while they are here. If you are interested in having the team over for dinner, please contact Amy.

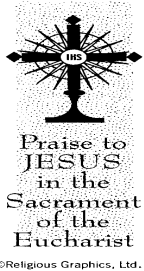
Parish Staff on Retreat - June 1 and 2
